I got the right tratment at Causeway and qucikly I cannot fault the Causeway experience but the Antrim experience I never will see again as I will never be back in the building.

I dont blame the staff - when they could see me they were very nice. I was brought in by ambulance with Heart Failure at 4pm and Acute Pneumonia. I was seen by a heart doctor at 12am. I spent the night on a trolly in a corridor, my daughter with me, she asked for a blanket for me as it was very drafty and they said there was none, My daughter had to threaten to STEAL one off another patient to get one. I lay on a trolly all night and the next morning I was discharged even tho my blood pressure was so high (the nurse thought the machine was broke and tested it with another it was that high) and my heart rate was over 120. The reason why I was discharged was clearly because they had no bed. I was number 7 on the bed queue and then I was number 25 as there had been more urgent cases in. For elderly who have no one to look after them like my daughter did for me - god help them. My daughter ended up helping others in the corridor who were also on trollys get their things, helped them in and out of bed to get to the bathroom, helped them with their breakfast and rang their familes for them. Nurses just hadnt time to do this. I worry that at 77 years of age, were do I go when I take sick again? I told my daughter that if she made me stay any longer that I would be dead. The fact that Antrim is what we are faced with if we take sick scares the life out of me.

After getting to Re-sus again overcrowded, craming people into small spaces. Then wheeled into the corridor and lay on a trolley, there was a queue of people lying on trolleys in front of me and when your unwell it doesnt help. Then taken to a cubicule sharing with some-one else, no privacy, no space and had to witness a man with alcohol consumed verbally abusing nursing staff, he entered my cubicile arguing and being aggressive to-wards a female nurse, this really distressed me, security was called but it was out of order, that type of behaviour puts strain on the doctors and nurses and upsets patients. As i am afraid of violence and with staff seeing my distress I believed they tried to see to me more quickly, I would probably of ended up lying longer, I was never so glad to get out of a hospital. The staff where brilliant, they were rushed off their feet and did their best. Mid-Ulster is very much missed and its so sad to see the health service plunging into complete despair.
